There are plans to design and pilot a Multidisciplinary Centre in the ACT to co-locate specialist sexual violence responses and services, creating a 'single access point for victim survivors to reduce trauma, stress and provide a holistic service response.' Can the Minister provide further details on this project, including the expected launch date and pilot duration?
 - a. What kind of support will the pilot centre mainly focus on providing immediate support to victims in crisis, short-term support post- crisis, or (if the pilot duration permits) will the centre aim to provide long-term or lifelong support as well?

Minister Berry: The answer to the Member's question is as follows: -

The ACT Government is committing \$4.367 million over 4 years to design and pilot a Multidisciplinary Centre (MDC) in the ACT to co-locate specialist sexual violence responses and services. The MDC will create a single access point for victim survivors to reduce trauma, stress and provide a holistic service response.

The first year of funding will be used to design, scope and plan the establishment of the MDC and will involve working with relevant stakeholders and considering models used in other jurisdictions. This process will guide which specialist services will be involved, the types of supports the MDC will offer and the duration of these supports for clients. This process will also determine an appropriate launch date and duration for the MDC pilot.
