MS LEE: So, and I think Mr Cahif also earlier talked about obviously utilities works as being part of this.

Mr Edghill: Yes.

MS LEE: Can you provide a specific figure for what the value of those works are?

Mr Edghill: Would be happy to do so. There are separate contracts for the utility works that do not fall within the main works contract but which are contracts which are separate to that and they also should be on the contracts register, but happy to take the value of those on notice and provide the exact response.

MS LEE: So just confirming, you are taking that on notice?

Mr Edghill: Yes, I can take that, yes.

Chris Steel MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:–

The current Early Utilities Contract for the Raising London Circuit Project actual spend is \$7,856,635 (excl. GST), noting that the work is ongoing.
