In relation to: Sections of the Bill that have mandatory requirements for consultation on DAs

**THE CHAIR:** Could you perhaps take on notice for us and give us the sections in which industry is mandatorily required to consult including on DAs because I heard a long list there and I did not hear the word DA. But if you could take that on notice and provide advice that would be very helpful.

**Mick Gentleman MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:-**

Industry is not mandatorily required to consult with the public, including about a development application prior to its lodgement. Industry is however, required under Section 98 of the Bill, to consult with the Design Review Panel about development applications where proposals meet certain thresholds, as outlined in the Regulation.
