Mr Wijemanne: So the next steps will be around, so, completing the, will be the next steps for the tender valuation report that we have completed for the 100 per cent PSP which is currently being finalised.

MR BRADDOCK: Sorry, so the tender valuation report to undertake what piece of work?

Mr Wijemanne: The 100 per cent PSP.

Mr Phillips: 100 per cent preliminary sketch plans.

MR BRADDOCK: Okay.

Mr Phillips: I think there is a tender report on completing 100 per cent preliminary sketch plan on Casey on a building.

MR BRADDOCK: And when is the scheduled or anticipated completion date for the PSP?

Mr Wijemanne: I will have to take that one on notice.

MR BRADDOCK: Thank you.

Mick Gentleman MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

The due diligence and concept design work (30% Preliminary Sketch Plan (PSP)) for the new ACT Fire & Rescue and ACT Ambulance Service facility proposed for the Gungahlin Region was completed in June 2024.

The next stage of the project is to develop the 100% PSP for the preferred site. A tender evaluation process is currently being finalised to engage a consultant to develop the 100% PSP. This stage of the project is scheduled for completion by the end of June 2025.
