**Request to Elaborate on Evidence – Opportunity to Review Transcript - Inquiry into Appropriation Bill 2024-2025 and Appropriation (Office of the Legislative Assembly) Bill 2024-2025**

I wish to elaborate on information provided to the Select Committee on Estimates 2024-2025 during the appearance by the Justice and Community Safety Directorate on Friday, 2 August 2024.

On reviewing the Proof Hansard, I would like to take the opportunity to clarify the response provided, as captured in the Proof Hansard on Page 1033:

*Ms Cvetkovski: That includes various upgrades to infrastructure to address infrastructure compliance issues and hazardous material that was identified during the 2018 audit. This project follows on from the Delivering Better Facilities Phase 1 project which included access lift and lighting upgrades to the Winchester Police Centre and traffic operation command, previously located in Belconnen. The Delivering Better Facilities Phase 2 project includes:*

- *Upgrading of the holding cell (completed June 2024)*
- *The replacement of the Heating Ventilation and Air Conditioning (HVAC) system (completion scheduled for December 2024) for City Police Station. (Due diligence and design have been completed and currently seeking contractor for installation).*
- *Planned HVAC system upgrade (completion scheduled for June 2025) at Winchester Police Centre (Due diligence and design have been completed and contractor has been engaged for installation).*

In addition to the response above, I would like to clarify that the answer provided in the hearings related mainly to the Delivering Better Facilities (DBF) Phase 1.

The \$6.575 million presented in the Budget Statements D relates to DBF Phase 2.
