Report tabled – Inquiry into the Administration of Bail in the ACT

Today the Chair of Standing Committee on Justice and Community Safety, Mr Peter Cain MLA, tabled the Committee's report for its *Inquiry into the Administration of Bail in the ACT*.

The Committee has made 17 recommendations, including that the ACT Government enhance bail support in the ACT with a view to helping people meet their bail conditions, avoid re-offending while on bail and reducing numbers of people in remand in custody in the ACT. A dissenting report was made by Mr Peter Cain MLA.
