1. How much has the Government spent on removing graffiti over 2023/2024?
 - a) How many teams are there, and what is the composition of these teams?
 - b) Is the ACT Government planning on investing more funding into these graffiti clean-up teams given the increase in demand across all suburbs in Canberra?
2. How many dedicated areas are there for graffiti art and where are they?
 - a) How are these sites managed?

Ms Tara Cheyne MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

1. Transport Canberra and City Services (TCCS) has spent \$0.63m on removing graffiti from TCCS managed public assets in 2023/24.
 - a) Graffiti removal is an outsourced service. The contractor has two teams (north and south) consisting of up to two people each.
 - b) No. The current contract is fixed price, with the scope of Place Management and Roads ACT assets defined. Assets outside of this scope requiring servicing is undertaken by direct quote.
2. There are 30 legal graffiti sites around Canberra. A map of the locations is publicly accessible at [Legal graffiti practice walls - City Services](#)
