Minister A common theme in the Barriers to Participation in Community Sport Inquiry found that there is a shortage of indoor sports facilities.

- will you develop an indoor sports facility strategy and a costed action plan by the end of 2026?

Yvette Berry, MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

There is no intention to develop a specific indoor sports facility strategy at this time. However, planned works within this term of government will be reflected in the soon to be released four-year Sport and Recreation Facilities Roadmap, which will include the expansion of the Belconnen Basketball Stadium and planning work for multi-court indoor sports facilities in Woden, Gungahlin and Molonglo.

The ACT Government has and continues to work closely with Basketball ACT during the planning and design phase of the Belconnen Basketball Stadium expansion project.

The ACT Government also continues to deliver additional indoor court facilities through the delivery of new and upgraded ACT Government school facilities.
