Hi P01 and P01

Following on from the conversation P01 had with you P01 on Tuesday morning (about P01 telling us an educator had been roughly hitting/patting him on Monday and being told he wasn't to move or put his hand up) we have a few further concerns.

Today, P01 told us an educator pulled him by the ear roughly. He told us when he cried the educator told him 'not to cry'.

P01 also reported educators are putting children (unclear if it was him or others) in a naughty chair away from others when they do something 'naughty'.

As you can appreciate we are concerned about these reports. Noting he is 3 years old and may have misunderstood the circumstances, we still believe him and do not agree with some of these approaches - specifically the pulling of his ear and telling him not to cry. He was quite upset and we are concerned.

Can you please come back to us with your views on the above. We would appreciate confirmation/reassurance that P01 is not being handled physically like this and that educators are being supervised.

In addition can you tell us the Centre's approach to behaviour management - is the naughty chair common practice?
