On behalf of the members of our Branch, I wish to make some points as to how the present bus schedules affect them.

Because the majority of our members are seniors, not many drive cars so they need to use ACTION buses frequently. They find the long waits between buses on the routes servicing this area (33, 35, 36, 38, 39 and 48) inconvenient. Making connections with other routes is also a problem especially when medical appointments are involved. Again because of our age group, these can be regular occurrences. As you will appreciate, on these occasions, long waits at bus stops can be detrimental to people's health. Unfortunately, for financial reasons, many cannot afford to use taxis.

We appreciate that changes to timetables are now in place and we hope some of these will ease the situation in our area.
