I am interested in Directorates and Agencies' contractual arrangements -

Can you advise the how many contracts entered into by each Directorate or Agency since October 2012 have been with companies based in the ACT

How many are with companies based outside the ACT?

The relevant time period is from October 2012 (last election date) to present.

Mr Simon Corbell MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:-

The ACT Government Contracts Register records contracts with suppliers of goods, services and works, currently with a value of \$25,000 or more. This data is published on the Shared Services Procurement Website at:

Information on these contracts is also included in Directorate Annual Reports in the section on Government Contracting. Annual Reports are available on Directorate websites.

Data on contracts with a value of less than \$25,000 is not currently assembled and held centrally by the Directorate, and it would require significant diversion of Directorate resources from ongoing business to obtain, review and collate such information. As such I am not prepared to authorise the Directorate to divert resources to provide the information sought.
