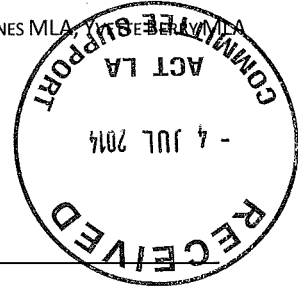

In relation to: Training Profile

My supplementary related back to the training profile in your attachment and further to the questions asked on graphic design and fashion. I refer to page 32, certificate III in automotive mechanical technology, where 2013 had 52,700 nominal hours and that has gone to zero for 2014. It is page 32, certificate III in automotive mechanical technology, C32198.

The Minister for Education and Training: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:-

The program "C3-2J98 Certificate III in Automotive Mechanical Technology" was delivered in 2013 with a target of 52,700 training hours. Changes to the national Training Package have resulted in this activity being moved into three new programs for 2014. These are:

C3-TC37 Certificate III in Light Vehicle Mechanical Technology
 C3-TC39 Certificate III in Heavy Commercial Vehicle Technology
 C3-TC40 Certificate III in Mobile Plant Technology

Details of these programs are on pages 33 and 34 of CIT's Statement of Intent.

1. QTON answers must be lodged in signed hard copy (not emailed) to the Committee Support office within **5 working days of the hearing day when the question was taken on notice**. Day 1 is the first working day after the day of the hearing in which the question is taken on notice. **Example:** If the question is taken on notice on Monday, you must submit the answer by close of business the following Monday. This applies even if the hearings for the portfolio stretch across several days.
2. Where an answer provides a referral to sources of information in published documents, the answer should include the exact name of the document, the author and agency publishing the document, the specific page number/s, and a hyperlink to the document, if it is published on the internet.
