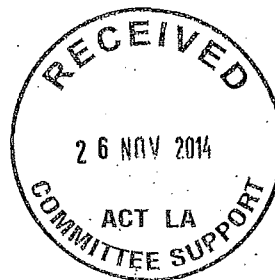
Subject: Mr Fluffy

My mother is 92 years of age, with restricted mobility (reliant on a 4 wheeled walker) is the owner / occupier of a Mr Fluffy house which has been environmentally cleaned twice.

She wishes to stay in her home but requires in home assistance. The difficulty is that the only official document issued / received describing her home states the house has been 'remediated as required by the Taskforce.'

With this document alone, she cannot get some health service providers to visit her at home. Plainly the wording of the document is inadequate, it should further state that the house environment is suitable in which to conduct normal household activities / house visits.

She would like a system where she can stay in her home, have the house declared safe and have the health support she needs to see out her final years.
