TERMS OF REFERENCE

INQUIRY INTO THE LOOSE-FILL ASBESTOS INSULATION ERADICATION SCHEME

In its report on the Appropriation (Loose-fill Asbestos Insulation Eradication) Bill 2014–15, the Committee noted that successful implementation of the Loose-fill Asbestos Insulation Eradication Scheme (the Scheme) would effectively require a coordinated approach across several directorates and agencies. To ensure adequate coordination and monitoring, the Committee recommended that the Government table quarterly progress reports on the implementation of the Scheme.¹

The Government agreed with the recommendation stating:

The Government has already agreed to do so. The Chief Minister's Ministerial Statement on 30 October 2014 was the first such report.²

Accordingly, as an ongoing inquiry—the Committee will inquire into all tabled quarterly progress reports, and report to the Assembly:

- 1) on any items or matters in those reports, or any circumstances connected with them, to which the Committee is of the opinion that the attention of the Assembly should be directed; and
- 2) any other relevant matter.
