In relation to: the value of the building and construction industry to the ACT economy

1. What is the total value of the building and construction industry to the ACT economy?
2. What proportion of gross state product does that total value represent in the ACT?
3. How does that total value compare to other industries?

Mr BARR MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:—

1. The total value of the construction industry to the ACT economy in 2016-17 was \$2,279m¹.
2. This represents 6.0 per cent¹ of the ACT economy in 2016-17.
