## Inquiry into ACT Budget 2021–22 ANSWER TO QUESTION ON NOTICE

Asked by Nicole Lawder MLA:

Ref: Table 16: Changes to Appropriation, Budget Paper H, Page 27

In relation to: New RSPCA Facility

1. I note the \$1.025 million allocated over a four-year period for early design works for a new RSPCA in the 2021-22 Budget.

What possible sites are currently being investigated for the new RSPCA?

- a. To clarify, is it a relocation of the existing RSPCA in Weston or is it a new RSPCA? When is it expected to move?
- b. How will this new proposed site compare to the current Weston location on a per sqm basis?
- c. Has RSPCA indicated their willingness to move now, given they called a halt to previous relocation plans?
- d. What is planned for the Weston site if the RSPCA move?

Mr Chris Steel MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:-

- 1. Two sites have been identified as suitable for accommodating the RSPCA facility, these sites are located in Symonston and Pialligo.
  - a. Relocation of the existing RSPCA facility in Weston. Timing of the move is dependent on further progression of concept planning and design, and future budget processes.
  - b. The RSPCA is currently located on a 2.8Ha site. Based on feedback from the RSPCA and concept planning work undertaken, the new facility should be located on a site that is approximately 4.0Ha to meet current and future operational requirements.
  - c. Yes.
  - d. The Weston site will be used for a purpose consistent with its zoning under the Territory Plan.
