In relation to: The 2021-2022 ACT Health Budget Statement, "providing health assessments and care for people detained in corrective facilities" on page 40

- 1. How much funding is JHS receiving to provide healthcare services to detainees in the AMC for the 2021-2022 financial year?
 - a. Does this figure differ at all from what was originally funded last financial year?
 - b. If this financial year's funding is lower than last years, why?
 - c. Can a breakdown be provided for the total funding JHS will be receiving?

MINISTER DAVIDSON: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

- 1. \$7.447million.
 - a. Yes.
 - b. Not applicable, as the funding is not lower.
 - c. The breakdown of 2021-22 funding of \$7.447m is:
 - Forensic Mental Health Services
 - Justice Health Services Central Management \$1.043m
 - Justice Health Primary Health (AMC) \$5.237m
