Inquiry into ACT Budget 2021–22 QUESTION ON NOTICE

JOHNATHAN DAVIS MLA: To ask the Minister for Health

Ref: Canberra Health Services, Budget paper C, page number 40, Output 1.2: Mental Health, Justice Health and Alcohol and Drug Services

In relation to: Disability Health Strategy

1. I note that the Parliamentary and Governing Agreement commits our government to developing a disability health strategy. How is the Minister hoping this work will progress over the coming year to ensure we are in a strong position to move forward on it at this time next year?

MINISTER STEPHEN-SMITH - The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

- 1. The Disability Health Strategy (DHS) Project commenced in April 2021 and has been broken down into three phases:
 - Phase One (Scoping Study to inform DHS) final report due December 2021;
 - Phase Two (DHS and First Action Plan (FAP) development) 2022; and
 - Phase Three (launch and implementation of DHS and FAP) 2023.

Phase One will see two reports developed in December 2021 including a consultant's report, Future Directions of Disability Health in the ACT: Phase One of the ACT Disability Health Strategy Project, and a Listening Report.

The process for developing the Disability Health Strategy is modelled on the process used to develop the Disability Justice Strategy 2019-2029, which was well-received by the sector.
