Elizabeth Kikkert: To ask the Minister for Corrections

Ref: Corrections, Budget Outlook, page number 331, output class 2.1, subheading “Corrective services, courts, tribunals and accommodation”.

In relation to: Line item “Additional classroom at Alexander Maconochie Centre”

1. In what part of the AMC will this classroom be built?
2. What can be taught in this classroom (i.e. could it be used for specialised instruction in woodworking or other crafts)?
3. After this classroom is complete, how many purpose-built classrooms will there be at the AMC?

Mick Gentleman MLA: The answer to the Member’s question is as follows:–

1. This classroom will be built in building F (Facilities).
2. This classroom is for staff training and will enable multiple training sessions to be conducted simultaneously on site.
3. Once this classroom is completed, there will be two purpose-built classrooms for training staff at the AMC.
