The answer to the Member's question is as follows: -

- 1. Can the OVC provide details such as the date of the court ruling referenced under subheading "Management Unit changes" on p28 of the report?
 - a. Is this the same court ruling referenced in the case study on p29?
 - b. Was the detainee referenced in the case study on p29 offered any sort of compensation by ACTCS?

The court ruling referenced was 'NATHAN DAVIDSON V DIRECTOR-GENERAL OF THE DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE AND COMMUNITY SAFETY DIRECTORATE SC 328 OF 2020'. This is the same court ruling referenced in the case study. I am unaware of any details regarding compensation.

2. Can the OVC go into further detail on the "additional level of punishment" being implemented on detainees in the management unit?

Additional punishments / restrictions of which detainees in the management unit complained include no access to cigarettes/nicotine, no access to TV/radios, increased restrictions to phone calls, no access to coffee/caffeine, and blocked access to courtyards.
