Mr Marshall: Thanks, Minister. There are, in some circumstances, grounds for users of public infrastructure to make a claim in relation to damages of various types. And there are processes by which TCCS will consider those claims and, in some circumstances, some compensation will be paid. But those are, you know, subject to the specific details of each specific case.

MS LAWDER: So how many claims have there been each year, over the past five years, that have been approved for payment?

Mr Marshall: I would have to take the question on notice to have to give the statistical details.
