ANSWER TO QUESTION ON NOTICE

Elizabeth Lee MLA: To ask the Chief Minister

1. Broken down by each Minister's office since the commencement of the Tenth Assembly, please advise:
 - a. The current FTE and headcount.
 - b. The number of employees during this period who have commenced employment.
 - c. The number of employees who have ceased employment.
 - i. The reasons for these departures.
 - d. The number of ministerial staff departures that have resulted in payouts beyond the usual payout of annual leave and/or long service leave (such as ex gratia or extraordinary payments), and the total of each.
 - e. The number of employees who were terminated.

Andrew Barr MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows: –

1. All ACT Executive staff are pooled and employed by the Chief Minister so no further breakdown can be provided.
 - (a) As at 30 June 2021:
 - Total FTE - 62.6
 - Total headcount – 68
 - (b) 54 employees commenced employment since the start of the 10th Assembly. This number does not include staff that continued employment from the 9th Assembly into the 10th Assembly.
 - (c) 23 staff have ceased employment with the ACT Executive.
 - (i) There have been 21 resignations and 2 voluntary redundancies. This number does not include staff that ceased employment at the end of the 9th Assembly.

- (d) Two staff took voluntary redundancies that resulted in payouts beyond the usual payout. The total of cost has been combined to ensure privacy and is detailed below.

- (e) There have been no employees terminated since the commencement of the 10th Assembly.
