Canberra Institute of Technology does not deliver Auslan courses.

CIT Solutions, a subsidiary of CIT operating under the *Corporations Act 2001* (Cth), delivers recreational courses in Auslan 1 and Auslan 2. These are non-accredited courses and do not attract ACT Government funding.
