- 1) Are either the Spence or Macquarie ovals receiving upgrades this financial year?
 - a. If so, what is the nature of these upgrades?
 - b. If not, are they being funded in the forward estimates?

- 1) No. Both sites are considered dryland ovals. The irrigation to these sites was turned off in 2001 in response to water saving measures caused by the drought.
