Shane Rattenbury MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows: –

All proposals considered in the Budget include a Wellbeing Impact Assessment (WIA) and decisions are informed by analysis of that assessment. The purpose of the WIA and the Gender Analysis Tool is not to change budget decisions. They are used to inform Budget decisions. Budget decisions reflect the endorsement by Cabinet of recommendations by ERC. The Government publishes Budget decisions in the Budget and Budget Review.
