MR BRADDOCK: The business case also advised that, “The WHS representative conducted a full workplace health and safety assessment of Rosenbauer vehicle and prepared it with the existing vehicles”—blah, blah, blah. Who was responsible for actually conducting that workplace health and safety assessment?

The Auditor-General's report notes that:

The Business Case advised 'the (JACS) work health and safety representative conducted a full workplace health and safety assessment of the Rosenbauer concept vehicle and compared it with existing vehicles and the recorded injuries associated with existing vehicles' and that 'this report formed part of the feasibility study and overwhelmingly supported the concept design and progression to the prototype'.

The workplace health and safety assessment was undertaken by the JACS WHS team, and was completed in September 2019.
