MR BRADDOCK: Just as a supplementary to that, as part of that would it be possible to know how many of those are minor administrative breaches versus actually committing an offence.

DR PATERSON: Like any detail.

Mr Rattenbury: It sort of goes back to the previous one. We will see what data we can extract in that space.

[Mr Shane Rattenbury MLA]: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

ACT Policing is unable to provide the nature of each individual breach of bail condition as this would require a significant manual interrogation of the Police Real-time Online Management System (PROMIS).
