Minister. The Director-General Community Services Directorate (DGCSD) advised that a delivery schedule has been developed for properties that are part of the Growing and Renewing Public Housing Program. The DGCSD advised that the delivery schedule is not a public document as it 'changes all the time .. we don't want to publish that schedule because it changes hour to hour let alone day to day'.

- (1) Can you provide a copy of the schedule as at 26 July 2024? The information sought should exclude block identifiers, the names of the architects or the builders.

Yvette Berry: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

The schedule is not a fixed document. We can provide information as at 30 June 2024. On 30 June 2024, 614 construction deliveries have been completed.

Across the three remaining years of the Growing and Renewing Public Housing Program (2024-25 to 2026-27), CSD estimates the to be 492 dwellings delivered via construction.

The current forecast is:

- In 2024-25, CSD forecast the delivery of 182 dwellings.
- In 2025-26, CSD forecast the delivery of 124 dwellings.
- In 2026-27, CSD forecast the delivery of 186 dwellings.

The remaining additions to meet the 1400 target will be achieved through the purchase mechanism.
