MS CARRICK: Do you do the athletics track too at Phillip?

Mr Iglesias: I believe we do. We are talking about public—you mean, the enclosed athletics track. Yes, yes.

MS CARRICK: It is a great facility. I drove past it. It looks fantastic but I do get representations about the lack of parking.

Mr Iglesias: Yes, that is one of the sites where space is at a premium, and I do believe we have in the past made an effort to activate a particular site for overflow parking, but I wonder whether that particular site is just restricted by its geography. I do not know for sure so maybe I will investigate that one and take that on notice.

MS CARRICK: Not the site north of it because I have got other ideas for that.

Mr Iglesias: I can look into it and give you a fulsome answer. I will take it on notice.

MS CARRICK: Thank you. The cemetery is there but I know we cannot use that. But one day—

Yvette Berry MLA, Minister for Sport and Recreation: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

Woden Park Athletics track has 50 identified parking spaces internal to the facility. The neighbouring Phillip District Playing Fields, off Kitchener Street, and the car park off Justinian Street near Eddison Park, have 33 and 40 car parking spaces respectively.
