Rachel Stephen-Smith MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

The ACT Revenue Office uses a range of software tools. This includes the Microsoft Business Intelligence Software suite, R, Power BI and GraphDB.

For purposes of administering the ACT tax laws, the ACT Revenue Office has access to a range of data, including but not limited to the Australian Taxation Office, the Australian Business Register, ACT Rental Bonds, ACT rego and utilities.
