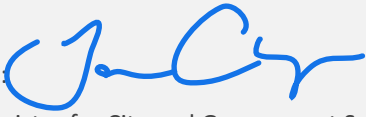
1. What is the current status of the establishment of the “Hall Village Main Route” sealed pedestrian and cycle path announced last March by Federal Minister King and ACT Minister Cheyne?
2. When will the proposed alignment and design of the “Hall Village Main Route” be discussed with Hall community stakeholders prior to its finalisation?

Ms Tara Cheyne MLA: The answer to the Member’s question is as follows:

1. The new project jointly funded by the ACT and Commonwealth Government’s to deliver the Hall Village Main Route has commenced planning and procurement work.
2. The proposed alignment of the Hall Village Main Route will be shared with targeted key community stakeholders, including the Hall Progress Association, adjoining land leaseholders and the ACT Equestrian Association in the first quarter of 2026. Their feedback will inform the detailed design stage. A feasibility study was undertaken in 2024-25. In early 2025, the Hall Progress Association were consulted during the feasibility study stage, and a draft alignment was shared with the Association at that time.
