Mr Parton: So how many more of the Yutong E12s are still to be delivered and actually transitioned into service?

Mr Steel: We will take that on notice again, but—

Mr Smith: Sorry, it will be the balance between that 106 under the current contract and the exact number that we would accept delivery.

Mr Chris Steel MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

As of 1 November 2025, in relation to contract GS2404889 executed in May 2023 for the supply of 90 *Disability Discrimination Act* compliant electric buses and ancillary goods, there are 8 Yutong E-12 buses remaining to be delivered of the agreed 90.

In addition to this, there are currently 12 leased Yutong buses and 4 leased Custom Denning buses in service.
