Ms Williams took on notice the following question(s):

THE CHAIR: Quick supplementary, if that is alright. Do you have data on alcohol-related violence on your drivers? Have you got on that?

MR WERNER-GIBBINGS: That is interesting.

Ms Lloyd: We have looked into that and in the ACT, we do not have any incidents of that nature. We have had in other jurisdictions in relation to an alcohol delivery, a safety report reported to Door Dash, and it has also gone to the police, which is obviously the appropriate outcome in that instance. But we have not had any in the ACT and I would say--well, I do not have total numbers across the country in front of me. It is a very small number of deliveries which result in a safety report coming from the driver.

THE CHAIR: Thank you.

Ms Williams: We can take that on notice to also provide.

THE CHAIR: For Uber.

Ms Williams: But similarly it would be a small proportion of deliveries.

UBER EATS: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

In the ACT, since July 2023 when we launched alcohol delivery, there have been two incidents reported by delivery people in relation to physical altercations with a delivery recipient on an alcohol delivery.
