- **Faddon Ponds Carp removal**

Following successful public consultation in early May, Conservation Research with assistance from Transport Canberra and City Services (TCCS) and Parks and Conservation Service intend to remove carp and other exotic fish from Fadden Pond on Wednesday 30 May 2018, weather permitting. The fish poison Rotenone will be used and the fish removed from the site by Conservation Research and TCCS staff. The process is safe for people and pets, but the pond will not be available to the public for 24-48 hours. Nearby facilities, including the playground, will not be affected.

The pond is an upstream source of carp for Isabella pond and will hopefully result in improvement to water quality for both Fadden pond and Isabella pond and protect the Healthy Waterways Strategy Program's investment in Isabella and Upper Stranger Pond.
