Ms Kate Lundy took on notice the following question(s):

MS CLAY: Sure. I would love to know what source of information you got from whom in October, November and December about the allegations, whether those sources came from outside sources, or whether they came from Dr McNeill, and whether they said there were ongoing allegations, whether there were proven findings, or whether they said there was nothing to see.

Ms Lundy: Okay. We will capture that. Thank you. We will take that on notice.

Mr Tom Rogers: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

I am advised that the previous Chair of the Board received correspondence on 23 September 2025 from the Integrity Commission providing an anonymous complaint which indicated that the investigation has been completed and that allegations made regarding serious wrongdoing and/or misconduct were substantiated.

Following receipt of this correspondence the previous Board Chair talked to Dr McNeill and wrote to TAFE NSW, the Minister and the ACT Public Sector Standards Commission.

The CEO advised the then Board Chair verbally of the NSW findings on Friday 12 December 2025 and written confirmation was provided on Thursday 18 December 2025.
