Ms Ramsay took on notice the following question(s):

**MRS MORRIS:** Okay, great thank you. How much does the authority spend on security for events in public places?

**Mr Gillman:** We operate through an events provider, Dionysus. They are the ones who have put together the security contracts for their events that they put on. So actually I do not have that information.

**MRS MORRIS:** Are we able to get that information on notice?

**Mr Gillman:** Yes, in the budget proposals from Dionysus we would have that as a line item. I am just checking.

**Ms Ramsay:** Yes, I am sorry, I should have said also, my name is Jen Ramsay and I am the EGM, Enabling Operations and I have read and understood the privilege statement. I am sorry I did not say that earlier. Yes, we could provide a percentage breakdown of what is spent on security as part of that. I do not have that off the top of my head, but it is a portion of each event. As you would expect for any event, you would spend money on security for that.

**MRS MORRIS:** Okay, thank you.

Mr Craig Gillman The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

During the 2025/26 financial year, City Renewal spent \$193,758.25 (ex GST) on security for all events delivered as part of the annual place experience and marketing program.
