Question on Notice Arts 17

Question to the Minister for the Arts and Heritage –

In relation to the ANU Faculty of Arts funding –

1. Why did funding for the Community Outreach Program fall by \$200,000 from 2008 to 2009?
2. How much is the funding for the Community Outreach Program under the Deed of Grant that was signed in May 2009 (ref vol 2, p 161)?
3. What is the split of the total funding between the School of Art and the School of Music? What is the rationale for that split?
4. Will the Minister provide the committee with a copy of the Deed of Grant? If not, why?

Mr Stanhope: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

1. In 2008, \$200,000 was provided to the ANU to support the use of Llewellyn Hall by ACT music organisations. For 2009, this amount was not provided to the ANU and was instead administered by the ACT Government for the same purpose.
2. Funding for the Community Outreach Program for 2009 was \$1.4m.
3. The School of Music programs received \$782,000 of the funding and the School of Art programs received \$243,000 of the funding in 2009. The amounts are based on negotiations between the ACT Government and the ANU.
