Mr Jeremy Hanson asked the **Minister for Police and Emergency Services**, upon notice, on 26 June 2014:

In relation to: Extra Police on the Beat

Mr Hanson: Into the liquor licensing team that you have disbanded?

Mr Corbell: Changed its name, but those extra police are doing their job as a dedicated enforcement capability.

Mr Hanson: They are making the shortfalls on the city beat are they not?


Mr Corbell: And the Chief Police Officer has given evidence to that effect previously. So, there are extra police on the beat. There are dedicated police enforcing liquor licensing as a result of that increase in fees but I am happy to give you the specifics of that on notice.

Ms Porter: Thank you, attorney, you will take that on notice. Mrs Jones, you have a supplementary.

Mr Simon Corbell MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:-

- (1) In September 2013 the RTT was formed as a result of the amalgamation of City Beats and the Alcohol Crime Targeting Team. The RTT maintains a high level of the Beat style policing in the CBD and continues to address all areas of the Alcohol Crime Targeting initiatives.
- (2) The team comprises three sworn Team Leaders, 20 sworn Team Members and one dedicated Intelligence Officer.
