Asked by Ms Nicole Lawder MLA: To ask the Minister for Transport and City Services

Ref: Transport and City Services, Annual Report

In relation to: Graffiti

In relation to:

1. How many complaints were made in 2021 relating to graffiti by residents?
2. What was the average amount of days it took to get graffiti cleaned once it was reported in 2021?
3. When will the graffiti on the sound barrier at Ashley Drive be removed?

Mr Chris Steel MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:–

1. During 2021, TCCS received 1,224 graffiti removal requests through our system.
2. The average time taken to remove graffiti once reported was approximately seven days.
3. The TCCS data system has no record of any recent requests in relation to graffiti on sound barriers on Ashley Drive. An inspection of the area will be undertaken and appropriate action will be carried out.
