**ANSWER TO QUESTION ON NOTICE**

Asked by Elizabeth Lee MLA:

Ref: Own Source Revenue

In relation to: Taxation

1. Can the Treasurer outline all new taxes that have been introduced as own-source revenue for each year since (and including) 2012-13?
2. Can the Treasurer outline the total revenue that has been collected from new taxes since 2012-13?
3. Can the Treasurer provide a detailed explanation of what S&P report released in September 2023, is referring to on page 3 when it discusses new tax initiatives ("Higher revenue from new initiatives") is referring to?
  - a. Please outline all new initiatives that this sentence is referring to and how much revenue will be collected from each new initiatives over the forward estimates?

Yvette Berry MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:—

1. Details on all new taxes that have been introduced since 2012-13 can be found in the relevant budget papers. New taxes introduced since this date are the Safer Families Levy (2016-17), and the Betting Operations Tax (2019-20).
2. Actual revenue outcomes can be found in Budget Review and Budget papers. In total, to 30 June 2023, \$111.3 million has been collected from the Safer Families Levy and Betting Operations Tax.
3. New revenue initiatives including estimated revenue over the forward estimates are outlined in the 2023-24 Budget Outlook, see pp 108, 114, 120, and 122.
