Dr Vaile: Access Canberra has worked with ANU in the development of a new tool called the regulatory value tool, which measures both regulatory value—

Mr Cocks: Yes. I will be really clear here, I am asking about burden, not value.

Dr Vaile: It does take into account regulatory burden as well as regulatory impact. So, it is trying to get a more holistic view rather than just the burden, but also whether the regulation is achieving the purpose that it sets out to achieve. So that tool is under development. It has been piloted and is hopefully going to be rolled out in the near future.

Mr Cocks: Okay. So, I have been given a similar answer every year over the past couple. When is it due to actually be delivered?

Dr Vaile: The pilot has actually been completed. It has been delayed a little bit by machinery of government changes at this point, and we are hoping to continue work on actually rolling that out more broadly in the new year.

Mr Cocks: Is there anything available that anyone can look at regarding the tool at this stage?

Dr Vaile: I think that the tool is actually available to look at, I believe.

Ms Cheyne: Let us take that on notice, and if it is, we will send it to you.

Mr Cocks: Thank you.

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Ms TARA CHEYNE MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

The Regulatory Value Tool was presented at an Australia and New Zealand School of Government event, 2 December 2024. The event was streamed and can be accessed at <https://anzsog.edu.au>; however the Tool itself is not yet publicly accessible in its native format.

The Tool is undergoing final testing by Dr Veronica Taylor, Professor of Law and Regulation at the Australian National University, with the User Guide to be published once it is endorsed.
