- (1) What collaboration does the Yarralumla Nursery have with local Landcare groups to supply them with suitable and reasonably priced plants?
- (2) How many plants have they provided to local Landcare groups?

Tara Cheyne MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

- (1) Yarralumla Nursery provides plants at wholesale prices. Local Landcare Groups can purchase plants from Yarralumla Nursery at wholesale prices. Yarralumla Nursery is listed on the Landcare Australia Website as a wholesale provider. Of the 50 Landcare groups in the Canberra region registered with Landcare Australia only one is registered with Yarralumla Nursery.
- (2) It is understood that local Landcare groups source plant material through the National Landcare Network, which administers volunteer-run nurseries that specialise in the size and variety of plant material used for land rehabilitation.
