Voluntary suspension of provider approval

At the end of the suspension period as an approved provider you must be operating an education and care service. Under Section 31(f) of the *Education and Care Services National Law (ACT) (the Law)*, the Authority has grounds to cancel a provider approval if the approved provider has not operated an education and care service for a period of more than 12 months (including any period of suspension). As an approved provider if you are not operating an education and care service you may choose to surrender your provider approval, through submitting a PA05 – Notification of Surrender of Provider Approval on NQAITS.
