Asked by Ms Clay:

In relation to: Coombs Peninsula

Report 9 of the Standing Committee on Planning and Urban Review was on the Draft Variation to the Territory Plan 360: Molonglo River Reserve – Changes to public land reserve overlay boundaries and minor zone adjustment. It is noted that all but one of the recommendations were not agreed to, meaning that the Coombs Peninsula will not be considered for environmental and recreational purposes. What is the current status of this development, and has an Estate Development Plan been drafted?

MINISTER STEEL: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:—

The Coombs peninsula does not form part of the Molonglo River reserve.

An estate development plan has not been prepared.
