Incident Management

Steps that were taken or will be taken to prevent or minimise this type of incident in the future

Detailed description of the incident including nature of risk, time, cause, etc.

OOSCA went into lockdown from 3.36pm until 4.24pm due to **P01** **P01** (child) violent outburst, extreme abusive language, and threatening and destructive behaviour directed at children and staff present. The incident started when another child refused to hand over a piece of rope she had to **P01**, and **P01** refused to have other pieces on offer from a staff member. The children were in lockdown in the OOSCA building, Library and Hall. The incident was occurring in the Sensory Garden. **P01** threatened to kill and harm staff and children present and attempted to enter the locked OOSCA building where staff and children were present. He used large sticks and ropes in a threatening way toward staff and children. **P01** destroyed large stick tent constructions the children had been working on over the last weeks. Children witnessing this incident were traumatized by the threats, language, destruction of property and the need to go into lockdown. As soon as an educator reported the start of the incident to the assistant director, the other children were moved into lockdown, the director was called to assist. The director then called **P01** **P01** Principal St Anthony's to assist and **P01**'s mother was called for immediate pick up. **P01**'s mother responded she could not be at OOSCA for another 40 minutes and all the emergency contacts listed were not available. Lockdown ended when his mother arrived at 4.24pm.
