Dr Marisa Paterson took on notice the following question(s):

MRS MORRIS: Yes. And with the prison population, can you tell me how many outlaw motorcycle gang members or groups are currently being detained in the AMC?

Ms Close: We do have intel analysis that highlights the different OMCG or gang-type affiliated people. I could take on notice—we have specific details about the actual numbers. The recent intel report I read there was at least about ten different groups and some of the groups form in the AMC, some of them are affiliated with well recognised motorcycle type gang or other organised criminal gangs from community groups that are—

MRS MORRIS: So ten different OMCG groups—

Dr Paterson: Type groups that come and go.

MRS MORRIS: —represented within the jail.

Dr Paterson: Yes. But I take on notice the actual number, but it was—

MRS MORRIS: That would be great, thank you.

Dr Paterson: We will take that on notice.

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MS CAITLIN TOUGH MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

As at 31 July, the Alexander Maconochie Centre accommodated 14 detainees associated with four OMCGs and one subgroup. These detainees are dispersed across all areas of the centre, with no concentration in any single accommodation unit. Three of the 14 OMCG associated detainees are on remand.
