Asked by MR PARTON:

In relation to: The previous MOU between Community Housing Canberra and the Land Development Agency - 120 dwellings stock supply each year

What agreement is in place now in terms of supply of undeveloped land to Community Housing Canberra?

MINISTER BERRY: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:–

The Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between Community Housing Canberra (CHC) Ltd and the former Land Development Agency (LDA) expired on 30 June 2017.

At present there is no agreement in place to supply undeveloped land to CHC.

The *Parliamentary Agreement for the 9th Legislative Assembly* commits the Government to “grow and diversify the not for profit community housing sector”.

In order to meet this commitment, the Government will regularly release land for community housing on a competitive basis to community housing providers and developers, to meet targets set under the *City Renewal Authority and Suburban Land Agency Act 2017*.
