When will you be implementing the priority recommendations from the Canberra Mountain Biking Report?

When will you build the flow trackfrom Stromlo to Cotter reserve?

MINISTER STEEL: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:-

The Best of Canberra Mountain Bike Experience project has commenced delivering on Recommendation 1 from the Canberra Mountain Bike Report – invest in new trail experiences. Trail Development Plans for three (3) iconic locations, Blue Range Uriarra Forest, Cotter Reserve, and a return trail linking from Stromlo Forest Park to Cotter Recreation Area will be finalised by April 2021. These take into consideration known (desktop) environmental and cultural heritage constraints. This marks the completion of the 2018-19 budget initiative to plan and design an iconic trail network.
