ANSWER TO QUESTION ON NOTICE

MRS KIKKERT MLA: To ask the Minister for Justice Health

Ref: Budget Statement C, Output 1.2: Mental Health, Justice Health and Alcohol and Drug Service, page 37

In relation to: Health staffing and mental health care at the Alexander Maconachie Centre (AMC)

- 1) How many psychologists are currently employed by the AMC, and what are their working hours?
- 2) How many psychiatrists are currently employed by the AMC, and what are their working hours?
- 3) How many detainees are on the waiting list to see a psychiatrist?
- 4) What is currently the longest waiting time for a detainee to see a psychiatrist?

MS DAVIDSON MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows: -

- 1) Custodial Mental Health currently employs three full-time psychologists who work Monday-Friday business hours.
- 2) Custodial Mental Health currently employs a consultant forensic psychiatrist three days a week and a psychiatry registrar full-time.
- 3) There is not currently a wait-list for psychiatry services.
- 4) Psychiatry appointments are scheduled according to clinical need. This includes same day assessment in the case of emergency. New admissions requiring psychiatry follow-up are typically seen within seven days depending on the triaged need. Where a detainee's psychiatric needs cannot be met in the AMC due to acuity or clinical need, they are transferred to inpatient facilities at Canberra Hospital or Dhulwa Mental Health Unit.
