Minister Yvette Berry: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:-

The Education Directorate and the Australian Education Union *Teacher Shortage Taskforce – Final Report (2022),* identifies that a projected 297 new teacher FTE is required in 2023 (table 6 – New Teacher FTE (scenario 3)) and sets out the numbers required for growth and for attrition.
